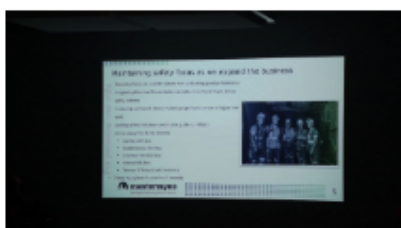

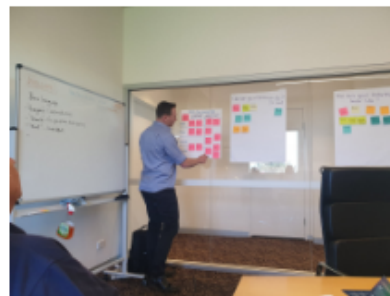
MyneSight Setting the Standard High

Aquila has been busy over the past few months, ensuring our people stay by developing our future leaders and upskilling the existing workforce. At the end of last year we had 20 employees complete supervisor courses.



More recently we utilised and shared an internal resource, Nathan Corbett, to facilitate a Cert IV Training and Assessing course and Cert IV upgrades. Nathan returned to complete 2 Trainer and Assessor courses which upskilled another 11 employees.

Aquila has facilitated these and a number of other courses including working at heights, first aid and lifting/slinging onsite, resulting in a reduction in cost and ensuring minimal disruption to production.

<p>A massive call out to C and D crews for their efforts over the weekend. With the two crews working together as a team and putting in the extra effort, they have brought the TG103 seal in 12hrs early. This in turn enabled the Longwall to start pulling chocks. Some of the milestones were 8 kibbles of concrete in the seal for a shift (that is over 20m3) and building the seal.</p>

Our community is devastated by the tragic death of Sharon France.

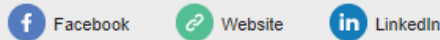
Sharon is the wife of Brad who works for Mastermyne at Moranbah North.
