

# Our First Cleanskins for 2020!





## Deputy's in Training

Mastermyne's 2020 Deputy Program has commenced! Queensland participants are first cab off the rank, with eight of Mastermyne's finest taking their first steps to become a Mine Deputy.

Over a 12 – 18 month period, these men will undertake study to complete their Certificate IV in Underground Coal Operations before moving through law and oral exams to become a Statutory Official. While completing the formal learning is important, at Mastermyne we know that it's practice and experience on the job that will be critical to each participant's success. Understanding this, participants will be linked with Mentors throughout the program who will offer guidance and practical experience opportunities along the way.

Dave Sykes (Mastermyne EGM, pictured far right) spent time with the guys last week to explain practical experience requirements of the program – what each participant can do to create their own opportunities to learn and how Mastermyne can support along the way. We look forward to kicking off the New South Wales Program in mid February.



## **Mates Helping Mates**








We have all seen through the multiple media channels the devastation that the bush fires are having on the country and the overwhelming impact its having on communities, the wildlife and individuals alike.
